even question it? One of my pastoral colleagues used to go on home visits and when the visit was complete they would ask the host for their Bible so they could read a passage for them. They said, that often, they would disappear for a long time before finally returning with a Bible. While I would never do that with parishioners, it does raise the question, where is your Bible?

As a student of the scriptures for well on five decades now, I always find it interesting when people say to me, "I know what the Bible says. I read it once." There is no possible way you can read the Bible once and grasp its nuances. This book is complicated. This book is creative. This book is unique. In my life it Holy Bible would be similar to picking up a book on quantum physics, reading the words and proudly

proclaiming that I am now a quantum physicist. Many of us, when looking for a professional, will do our due-diligence. If you were about to have surgery, would you just ask anyone to do the surgery? Nah...you'd probably get a referral from your doctor, ask a friend, or check their records with the state. One wants to make sure that their health is in the right hands.

Yet with our faith, we do not exhibit the same due-diligence. We gather biblical, spiritual, and faith advice and direction from any page on the internet that has a flashy operating system. We hear someone on the radio who will tell us what our itching ears want to hear. Or we will watch a program from a person in a huge stadium and think they MUST have it all together. Not necessarily.

Paul tells us to question everything. (I Thess 5:21) And that includes what we hear and read in the scriptures. The life of faith is vital. There is a reason God does not save us by our intelligence, but by the amazing grace we live in. We cannot always trust our intelligence. But as you read the scriptures, if you question something, reach out and see how others view it. Examine it from reliable sources that have knowledge of the scriptures and how they work.

We show ourselves to be responsible students of the scriptures when we put the work in to understand what we are reading.

When we learn the context of the scriptures we see what God is truly calling us to understand. And when we truly see God in the scriptures our lives and our world are changed.
