I hope to answer a few of these here.

- 1. Calling an Ambulance. One of the questions that got asked was "Should we call an ambulance? The answer to that is always "Yes." Our insurance requires that if anyone falls on our property, we have to call EMS for an evaluation. I know that many will not like this and think that it is too much of a fuss, but in the long run it is the best way to protect both the congregation and the injured person.
- We were asked about a blood pressure cuff. Thankfully, we have one.
 Regrettably, it was not where it could be easily accessed. We are currently in the process of moving the blood pressure cuff to the hook where the AED is also located.
- 3. AED (Automated External Defibrillator) is located to the left of the worship area doors as you enter from the gathering area. We are hoping soon to offer a course in CPR and AED for anyone that may be interested. If you are interested in being trained, please let me know. The AED is only to be used for cardiac emergencies. It is important to make sure you locate where the AED is next time you are in worship.

We are a public building and accidents will happen. We will always do our best to assure the safety and security of all our family and guests. Please be careful. Pay attention to what you are doing and give thanks for the community of faith we share.
