A Note from Pastor Bill and Other News

(Cont'd from pg. 1)

Many people use their birthdays as a time of reflection and self-evaluation. Not only will they celebrate, they may also take time to contemplate. They may look over their lives and discern what their next trip around the sun will look like.

We as Lutherans can do the same in our birthday month. We can look at the reformation of the church started by Martin Luther and ask ourselves how we are doing with Luther's vision. How are we doing with the goals Luther had for spiritual people in our world?

When the Reformation began, it was a call to return to the scriptures. Luther had gone through seminary and had never picked up a copy of the Bible itself. When he finally did, he realized the scriptures did not say what the prevailing culture (i.e. the Church) was saying. When he drew attention to it, he was excommunicated from the Roman Church and thus began the Re-Form-ation of the Church.

As a pastor and a theologian, one of the most difficult things is looking at our prevailing culture and seeing the gross misinterpretations of scripture being passed off as the Word of God. This cannot be. As it was in the times of Luther, people will still twist and manipulate scripture to either control people and/or gain power. That is why Jesus' teachings that the kingdom is not of this world was so mind boggling to the first century believers.

Paul tells us to "test everything."

(1 Thess. 5:21) There is a reason that admonition appears in scripture. The twisting and manipulation of the Word of God is not new. It occurred in the days of Jesus. It occurred in the days of Luther. It occurs today.

We are the people of the Reformation. We follow Martin Luther's call to be faithful to scripture and its interpretation. The process of Reformation is a continual process. Luther did not complete the work of reformation, he simply began it.

So, in this our birthday month, let us take the time to recommit ourselves to understanding the scriptures in their truest sense. Where we are in error, Adonai*, correct us. Where we are weak, strengthen us. Where people are in need, motivate us.

Welcome to the 2024/2025 GRACE KIDS Sunday School program!

The main focus of our program is our kids and building a sense of community with our families. We want our children to be a part of all aspects of church life, from participating in worship, to helping with charitable work, to having fun as a group with lessons, crafts, games and music.

We understand that our Grace Families have conflicting priorities — from school, to sports, to family events and beyond. We take those demands into account when planning our program calendar. We only plan for two Sunday school sessions each month and they are individual lessons that don't require regular attendance to be meaningful!

If you can only make it to one session every month or two that is OK. We want our families to know that they can come as often as they are able! Please do not feel you cannot come if you are only able to attend once in a while. Everyone is welcome at every session!

Some things that are new / updated this year:

- We are going to expand on splitting sessions with older and younger kids to include a junior youth group
- We are going to be forming a Children's ministry committee or as we call them here at Grace, a team. This team will help us to continue to expand on our Grace Kids ministry offerings and keep us moving forward.
- The Community Life team has many events that the kids and families can participate in above and beyond our Sunday Sessions


