Now, do not get me wrong, I am not begrudging anyone their time of leisure. I am not saying people should not take vacations and times of rest. All of this is important. Enjoy your trips. Spend time at the cabin. Enjoy the rest and travel you so greatly deserve. But, in the process, do not forget God.
