Art Piece Information

For the next few Sundays you will see a beautiful art piece hanging above the baptismal font. This art piece (a gift from some of our congregational artists) is a beautiful celebration of our past and our future.

The building depicted on the fabric hoops is what was affectionately called in Thiensville, "The little white church on the corner." Grace was the first congregation to build a permanent worship space in Thiensville. This building was located on the corner of Green Bay and Grand Ave (Where our parking lot is now.) This building served as our central place of worship until our current space was built in 1958.

The other two panels depict what is called the "Luther Rose." There is a great article on Wikipedia about this Lutheran "coat of arms". You can read more on Wikipedia under *Luther Rose*.

This piece centers us not only in our past and our tradition, but also reminds us of the ministry we have to the cross and the life of faith we all share in baptism. When we take a few moments in worship to look at and enjoy this work of art may God's Spirit guide us in our baptismal promises to share the gospel.

Intersex Awareness Day

On October 26, people across the country and the world will recognize Intersex Awareness Day. Intersex is an umbrella term for unique variations in reproductive or sex anatomy. Variations may appear in a person's chromosomes, genitals, or internal organs like testes or ovaries. Some intersex traits are identified at birth, while others may not be discovered until puberty or later in life. There are over 6 million intersex people in the United States alone. 1.7% of the world's population identify as intersex.

Persons who are born intersex often face many surgeries and abuse from those who do not understand what is going on with their bodies. Many families who are struggling with intersexuality will often face these challenges in private, since there is a stigma attached to intersexuality and our unwillingness to learn and understand it.

We are blessed in our faith community to have DawnMark who has helped to educate on the struggles and challenges of intersexuality. Without this personal perspective our congregation would not have challenged itself to understand and grow. DawnMark is available to discuss and answer any questions one may have about intersexuality.
