## **Scholarship Application (effective 10.10.22)**

### **Scholarship Opportunities**

The bylaws of the Grace Lutheran Church Endowment Fund provide that fund monies may be used in part to award scholarships to undergraduate or postgraduate college or technical school students each year. The value of each scholarship will vary according to the funds available for grants each year, the number of qualified applicants, and other Endowment requests. The scholarship amounts will typically be in the range of \$500-\$1000 per year.

### **Qualifications**

1. Scholarships are for students enrolled in full or part time undergraduate or postgraduate study, technical school or seminary. Seminary students will be given top priority for scholarship grants.
2. Students must maintain a grade point average of 2.5 or above to qualify for future scholarships.
3. Students must have been a confirmed member of Grace Lutheran Church for the past year.
4. Students must provide proof that funds were used for tuition or other allowable college expenses on an annual basis.
5. The Grace Lutheran Church Endowment Committee does not discriminate on the basis of race, age, color, sex, national origin, physical or mental disability, or any other basis protected by applicable anti-discrimination laws.

### **Application Procedure**

1. Applications may be picked up at the church office or acquired from the church website. Completed applications should be submitted to the church secretary (email is acceptable).
2. Applications may be made at any time; however, the Endowment Committee will usually make final grant decisions in December of each year. Please check with the church office to verify that your application has been received by the church secretary. Any questions should be directed to a member of the Grace Endowment Committee.
3. After reviewing all applications, the Endowment Committee will contact all applicants by email to inform them of the decision on their application. The Committee retains the discretion to approve or deny any grant request and to determine the amounts of each grant. Endowment Committee members will disclose any familial relationship to the applicant and abstain from consideration of the application.
4. Applications may be renewed on an annual basis.
