

We need you to make a difference to older people.

This service aims to provide company, reassurance, and low-level support to an older vulnerable person in their own home. This could be anything from a welfare check to offering some companionship when a delay is anticipated for Primary or Secondary care support. It can be a worrying time when older people are waiting for further support at home, our aim is to assign a volunteer to be that much needed "friendly face" for up to two hours.

This service currently covers Northampton and Wellingborough and the surrounding areas, including East Northamptonshire.

To join this rewarding service, we ask that you are:-

- age 18 or over
- a confident caring person with empathy for older people
- able to stay calm and offer reassurance
- living locally in the current service area

Your visit could include:-

- making a drink
- packing an overnight bag
- making someone comfortable following a fall
- contacting a family member or friend
- providing reassurance and a listening ear
- liaising with your Service Manager as required



Invite to Mental Wellbeing Support Workshop

Following a review of current arrangements for promoting mental wellbeing through a contract with MHNC was undertaken during the summer 2023, and which concluded that these arrangements were no longer sufficiently reflective of local public health priorities, both Councils stated in a letter to the VCSE sector their intentions to align future work on promoting positive mental health and wellbeing and preventing mental ill health with the Northamptonshire Mental Health Prevention Concordat, and NNC & WNC Health and Wellbeing Strategies, to ensure a more strategic approach.

A joint letter from North Northamptonshire Public Health and West Northamptonshire Public Health was issued on 21st February 2024 stating that each Council would be making separate commissioning arrangements going forward, based on considering local needs and the specific prevention investment and delivery arrangements that operate in their respective unitary authority areas. In this letter West Northamptonshire Public Health stated that it was planning a half day workshop on Friday 15th March 2024 - 9:00am – 2:00pm at The Great Hall, St Andrews Hospital, Northampton, to work with the MHNC and wider VCSE sector to co-produce their new service arrangements.


The overall aim of this half day workshop is to inform the development of a service specification and the service delivery arrangements for VCSE to support the mental health and wellbeing of local people, to be commissioned by Public Health. This will be achieved through Public Mental Health colleagues working with MHNC, VCSE Mental Health Thematic Assembly and wider VCSE organisations to co-produce the new service arrangements.

The objectives of the workshop include:

- sharing a strategic approach for improving public mental health in the Council area
- sharing key priority areas of work programmes, which are evidencebased and cost-effective
 - sharing some of the principles that will underpin the new service arrangements
- outlining proposed timeline for the new arrangements to be in place
 - co-developing ideas of delivery approaches to address strategic outcomes and priorities



North Northamptonshire Council are in the process of building a framework for designing its new five-year housing strategy in North Northamptonshire. Examples might include any of the following, or other suggestions:


- Developing or creating a new park
