Since the start of the outbreak SERVE has been able to provide over 500 shopping trips for those that have been shielding or isolated.

We have helped with over 130 prescription collections and deliveries and have made over 2700 telephone calls to our beneficiaries or others in the community requiring support.

A HUGE thank you goes to over 60 new volunteers in the community that have or are now volunteering for SERVE during this time to help support the work that we are doing. Many of these have been furloughed from their permanent employment and have joined us during the crisis to support those that are most vulnerable at this time.

Befriender Project

Nene Valley Community Action (a division of SERVE) took the decision (following Government advice) to socially isolate and distance our Volunteer Befrienders, and avoid face to face contact. This was not an easy decision to make but we needed to shield those vulnerable and at risk of infection. Staff at NVCA continued to contact their Befriendees by telephone each week to ensure they were keeping safe and well. Each week we have been sending our clients Word Searches, Crosswords along with a letter and drawing from local school children who have been keen to put pen to paper. This has made a huge difference to their wellbeing. Please see a couple of recent comments received from our clients.

"How very enterprising to get youngsters engaged in writing to us older ones, I congratulate you".

"Thank you for cheering me up, I love doing the puzzles".

"Really appreciate the phone calls each week".

Last week we went on Garden Visits (following social distancing guidelines) rather than contacting by phone. Our Befriendees were enjoying the lovely weather and displaying their drawings in their windows.

Our Volunteers have also been kept informed on how their Befriendees have been over the last few weeks. Here are some of their comments received.

Overview

SERVE is committed to providing the best possible care, well-being, and support to vulnerable adults in the community during the Covid-19 crisis.

SERVE is in partnership with the Community Resilience Hub set up by the Government which is being led by the District Councils. Our direct crisis service delivery is coordinating and supporting individuals in the community with essential groceries, prescriptions and hearing aid battery collection, along with 150 wellbeing / befriending telephone calls being made each week.

The partnership has a network of voluntary organisations including mental health support, family support and finance and benefits advice.

Complex cases are only going to increase in the local community and this project will enable us to prepare and manage the situation effectively and ensure consistent follow up care after the restrictions with social distancing are lifted.

Positive changes for beneficiaries

- Vulnerable adults will feel supported with mental health via virtual online support and telephone befriending
- Families will be supported by a professional team of family support links and youth counselling
- Vulnerable adults will be supported with their universal credit applications and finance/budget management
