Befriender Project

The befriending project continues to be busy with new referrals being received across all areas.

During November our Befrienders achieved over 399 volunteering hours. This includes 141 face to face visits including garden visits and 67 telephone befriending calls.

However, we need more volunteers to help meet the demands on the service. If YOU or someone you know could provide a minimum of 1 hour a week to visit an older person in their own home, we want to hear from you.

For some older people, a volunteer may be the only person they see in a week. Relationships can transform lives.
