### PRIORITY HEALTH OUTCOME GROUPS

#### Chronic Disease

Focuses on anything related to root causes or risk factors associated with cancer, hypertension, high cholesterol, and diabetes, such as healthy eating, physical activity, preventive screenings.

#### Avoidable Injury

Focuses on disparities in transportation (including public transit use and motor vehicle deaths), violence (firearm, homicide, domestic violence), falls in older adults, and vaccine usage.

#### Maternal and Infant Health

Focuses on disparities in maternal and infant health outcomes such as prenatal/postpartum access, preterm birth, low birth weight, and mortality.

#### Mental Health

Focuses on mental health access including insurance and provider rates as well as mental health conditions in both youth and adults.

#### Premature Death

Focuses on substance use including drug and alcohol use in youth and adults
