I am just going to say it, 2021 was a **hard year**. The Ministry pivoted every pivot we could pivot! To reach those needing food, we held more mobile food pantries than ever. To help those with tremendous financial needs, we asked ourselves, "What will it take to keep this person in their home?" then we did our best to meet that need. To work with less volunteers, the Ministry staff took on many more responsibilities than ever before. I want to say thank you to all of the volunteers that supported the Ministry this past year. You were asked to do harder jobs and did not let the Ministry down!

This year brought our clients financial hardships like those that we have never seen before. Thanks to each church, person, business and group for every dollar donated. Because of the record-breaking dollar amount donated, the Ministry broke a record in the amount of financial help given out.

POLICY AND PERSONNEL COMMITTEE REPORT

Just as we thought the Covid-19 virus was behind us, it returned with vengeance. We followed CDC guidelines throughout the year to ensure the safety of our staff, clients and volunteers.

Carla Goodson our Emergency Services Coordinator retired in August after 10 years of employment. Carla volunteered at the Ministry for many years prior to joining our staff, and we thank her for her care and concern for our clients. Bobbie Grant, Emergency Services Assistant who has many years of service to the Ministry, agreed to take Carla's position, and in accordance with our by-laws, all member churches were notified about the opening of Emergency Services Assistant. Betty Leonard was interviewed and hired.

We met again in October and discussed wage adjustments, a bonus pool and holiday pay and time off procedures for employees who work 10 hours per week.

Thank you to the entire staff for their excellent performance throughout the year, and thank you to the Policy and Personnel Committee for their involvement and input.

MOBILE FOOD PANTRY

2021 brought many more mobile food pantries. Christian Ministry has been blessed with an abundance of food and worked hard to distribute it throughout the community

This year, an estimated amount of 95,336 lbs. of food was distributed with a retail value of \$28,600.80. This was done in partnership with Second Harvest Food Bank (SHFB), 10 member churches, Lincoln County Schools and the YMCA. Working with the churches, the Ministry schedules food drops from SHFB on Fridays. The churches have volunteers at the church to help store the food away, then on Saturday morning, the volunteers give the food to clients. This year, volunteers worked at the Ministry to box food up, and then the Ministry delivered food to several mobile food pantries.

Over the past year an estimated 1,122 families (4,897 individuals) were helped through this ministry.
