Set up is available in the grassy area between the parking lot and splash pad, in the stage side of the event or on the cement under the cover next to the splash pad (*space is limited in this location*).

The festival does not supply tents, tables, electricity or water connections. *Small ‘quiet’ generators are acceptable*. There is limited access to electricity under the cover next to the splash pad. Space set up will be allowed, Friday 1-4pm and Saturday between 7 a.m. and 9 a.m. All vehicles must be removed from the festival by 9:30 a.m. Saturday.
