Cancelling 2022 Stir the Pot


Over the last two years, like most organizations who host events, Friends was significantly impacted by the mandates and the restrictions imposed due to the Covid 19 virus. Apart from the organization and the park, many people's interests, lives and priorities have been changed forever. As the virus mandates have been lifted, organizations having a large enough volunteer base seem to have been able to overcome the challenge of returning after two years of dormancy.

As a small non-profit made of mostly older volunteers, Friends of Palmetto has felt this challenge more significantly than most. This is the major hurdle that has forced Friends of Palmetto to cancel this event. Simply put, we cannot organize and host an event of this size on state property without a chairperson who has the time and energy to do things required and coordinate 30 plus volunteers. After searching and requesting for months, the organization was unable to find a volunteer who could give the event the necessary level of time and attention. We are grateful to all park patrons and campers who have been a blessing of support to this park and our events for over ten years. We could not do it without you. However, it takes a lot of volunteers and time both behind the scenes and in advance to execute this event and many others.

We know that patrons have been looking forward to this event's return and reservations have been made 13 months in advance. We considered how disappointed we know you all would be and tried to make changes to the event to make it more volunteer friendly or replace it with something else and still we came up with the same challenges. Sadly, at this time, Friends does not have the membership or volunteer base to host an event of this size. Having attendance at this event is no longer enough. Whether this event returns in the future is unclear. It almost certainly will not without the renewed support of volunteers and members. Park Comments and Suggestions



Gates are open 7am-9pm (Sun-Thurs) and 7am-10pm (Fri & Sat). Entrance station is open: 8am-5pm (Sun-Thur) 8am-8pm (Fri & Sat). All park sites close at 10pm on Friday, Saturday and days preceding holidays. Entrance Fees: \$3 per person; Free for Seniors (62 and older) and children age 3 and under. Canoe rentals are \$25 per day or \$7 per hour. The Splashpad is closed on Mondays for maintenance. Golf cart entry fees are \$10 per day or \$100 for annual pass (proof of insurance is required). Palmetto Island State Park has 96 camp sites, 6 cabins, 4 pavilions, 4 primitive backpack sites, 1 primitive group site and a meeting room to rent.
