CORK-LID TRAPDOOR SPIDER

Ummidia spp.

I was amazed when 'something' shiny, black and fast caught my eye as it crossed the parking lot at PISP. I had never seen anything like it and had to find out what kind of a spider it was. Special Thanks to the Facebook group Louisiana Insects and Arachnids for the 'id'. While common to Louisiana, they are rarely seen. Probably because they dig tunnels in the ground lined with silk. The front door is made of silk, soil and other things from around the entrance site. This acts as a fantastic camouflage. The door is hinged with stretchy silk, and its underside has holes so that the spider can spring out at just the right moment. This also allows it to hold the door tightly closed if a predator attempts to enter the burrow. The silk 'tripwires' around the entrance of their dens, signal that unsuspecting prey has come along and accidentally touch the silk. These distant relatives of the tarantula are about an inch long (I swear it looked bigger!), non-venomous and eat other bugs.

Latanier Cookers' D.O.G. 'CHOW'

PECAN PIE BROWNIES submitted by Shannon Neveaux

40 oz Brownie mix or 2 regular size mixes (plus ingredients listed on package)

Pecan Pie Filling:

1 c. sugar 1 1/2 c. corn syrup

4 eggs 1/4 c. unsalted butter (melted)

1 1/2 tsp vanilla 2 c. pecans (chopped)

Preheat oven to 350°. Mix brownies according to the package instructions. Pour brownie batter into a greased 13 x 9 in pan and bake for 25-30 min.

*If baking in a 12 in. Dutch Oven, take care that



batter does not touch the lid. May have to cook a little longer.* While baking, combine sugar, syrup, eggs, butter and vanilla. Mix well. Stir in pecans. After 25-30 min, pour the pecan pie filling over brownies. Bake 30-40 min or until the filling is only slightly jiggly in the middle when you move the pan. Let cool completely to room temperature before cutting. This will be 'gooey'! *For 12 in. Dutch Oven use 25 coals, 17 on top/ 8 on bottom. You may have to replace or add coals for second bake.*

You can still visit the park on weekends. The splash pad is open until September.



Park Hours of Operation:

Gates are open 6am-9pm (Sun-Thurs) and 6am-10pm (Fri & Sat). Entrance station is open: 8am-5pm (Sun-Thur) 8am-10pm (Fri & Sat). All park sites close at 10pm on Friday, Saturday and days preceding holidays. Entrance Fees: \$3 per person; Free for Seniors (62 and older) and children age 3 and under. Canoe rentals are \$25 per day or \$7 per hour. The Splashpad is open April-September, Tuesday –Sunday from 8am to 8pm. Golf cart entry fees are \$10 per day or \$100 for annual pass (proof of insurance is required). Palmetto Island State Park has 96 camp sites, 6 cabins, 4 pavilions, 4 primitive backpack sites, 1 primitive group site and a meeting room to rent.
