COOKING CRACKLINS AT PALMETTO ISLAND



LATANIER COOKERS' D.O.G. 'CHOW'

STRAWBERRY OAT BARS submitted by Patricia Treadway

- 1 pound softened margarine
- 1 1/3 cups sugar
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1 tsp salt
- 2 tsp cinnamon
- 1 cup oats
- 1 pound all purpose flour
- 4 tbsp Strawberry jam (per pan) or Flavor of your choice

Mix all above ingredients except jam. Spray bottom of 12-1/4 x 8-1/4 x 1-3/32 pan or a 12 in Dutch Oven. Spread about 2/3 of the oat mixture to cover the bottom of pan. Press into the bottom. (Reserve about 1/3 portion to crumble over top.) Cook at 350° about 20 minutes. Remove pan from oven. Spread Jam carefully on top of cooked oat mixture. Sprinkle more mixture on top of jam. Cook about 20 minutes or until golden brown.



PLEASE READ:

BY STATE LAW:

- I. Owners must show proof of liability insurance on their golf cart at the entrance station when they enter the park. Once an owner has shown proof of liability insurance, they will be given a blue tag to hang on their cart. This tag must be visible at all times.
- II. Only licensed drivers are allowed to drive golf carts in the park.
- III. Golf carts may only be driven between sunrise and sunset. They may not be driven after dark. Please make sure your cart is not on the road after sunset.

- 1. Golf carts are not allowed to ride around with music blaring from radios or boom boxes at any time.
- 2. Golf carts are only allowed on the roads and parking lots. Golf carts are not allowed on any trails, grassy areas, or any place where a car is not allowed.
- 3. Please do not put a child in your lap and allow them to “drive” the golf cart.
- 4. Do not exceed the maximum number of occupants for the cart. For example, if you have a 2-seater, then only 2 people are allowed in the golf cart.
- 5. Please do not pull the golf cart up to the Splashpad, picnic pavilions, bathrooms, etc.
- 6. Golf carts can only park in the parking lots alongside the cars.
- 7. Golf carts must follow the speed limit of 15 mph in the park.
- 8. Utility vehicles are not considered golf carts.

Volunteer fireman from Henry have been supporting Palmetto Island State Park for many years by participating in our cooking events. We'd like to return the favor and let you know about their annual cook off. They'll be at this year's cracklin cooking demonstration. Stop by their tent and find out more.

Park Hours of Operation:

Gates are open 6am-9pm (Sun-Thurs) and 6am-10pm (Fri & Sat). **Entrance station** is open: 8am-5pm (Sun-Thur) 8am-10pm (Fri & Sat). All park sites close at 10pm on Friday, Saturday and days preceding holidays. **Entrance Fees:** \$3 per person; Free for Seniors (62 and older) and children age 3 and under. **Canoe** rentals are \$25 per day or \$7 per hour. The **Splashpad** is open all year, Tuesday – Sunday from 8am to 8pm. **Golf cart** entry fees are \$10 per day or \$100 for annual pass (*proof of insurance is required*). Palmetto Island State Park has **96 camp sites**, **6 cabins**, **4 pavilions**, **4 primitive backpack sites**, **1 primitive group site** and a **meeting room** to rent. **Reservations** for overnight accommodations at Palmetto Island State Park can be made [online](https://www.lastateparks.com) or through the Call Center at 877.226.7652.
