Christmas Bird Count



The 6th running of the Palmetto Island CBC was held January 4, 2022. The count circle is centered at Palmetto Island State Park in Vermilion Parish. The species count total this year was 150 species, right on the 5 year average of 151 and the 6 year total count is now a very impressive 193 species, after adding 5 new species to the count this year. The count circle is in an unique area of Louisiana that is an intersection of major terrain trends. The circle includes bottomland hardwoods from old Vermilion/Mississippi River 'meanderings', coastal prairies, agricultural fields, freshwater marshes, 'urban' Abbeville down to the Cameron like industrial port of Intracoastal City. Park Comments and Suggestions



Gates are open 7am-9pm (*Sun-Thurs*) and 7am-10pm (*Fri & Sat*). Entrance station is open: 8am-5pm (*Sun-Thur*) 8am-8pm (*Fri & Sat*). All park sites close at 10pm on Friday, Saturday and days preceding holidays. **Entrance Fees**: \$3 per person; Free for Seniors (*62 and older*) and children age 3 and under. **Canoe rentals** are \$25 per day or \$7 per hour. The **Splashpad** is closed on Mondays for maintenance. **Golf cart** entry fees are \$10 per day or \$100 for annual pass (*proof of insurance is required*). Palmetto Island State Park has 96 camp sites, 6 cabins, 4 pavilions, 4 primitive backpack sites, 1 primitive group site and a meeting room to rent. **Reservations** for overnight accommodations at Palmetto Island State Park can be made online (*click button below*) or through the Call Center at 877.226.7652. **For more information** about the Park, visit www.lastateparks.com, call 888.677.0094 toll free or 337.893.3930 locally.
