LATANIER COOKERS' D.O.G. 'CHOW'

BLACK FOREST BUNDT CAKE submitted by Ray Castleberry

- 1 package Duncan Hines Moist Deluxe Dark Chocolate Fudge Cake Mix
- 3 large eggs
- 1 tbsp. Almond Extract
- 1 can (21oz) cherry pie filling
- 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips

GLAZE: 1 tbsp. butter 2 tbsp. milk

1/2 cup semisweet chocolate chips

1/2 cup + 2 tbsp confectioners sugar



Preheat oven to 350 and grease bundt pan. In a bowl, blend well, cake mix, eggs, pie filling and almond extract. Fold in 1 cup chocolate chips. Pour into pan and bake for 45-50 minutes, or until toothpick comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes. Remove from pan and allow to cool completely. Glaze: In a small saucepan over med-high heat, melt butter, chips and milk. Stir constantly. Do not burn. Once chips are melted add 1/2 c sugar. Spread Glaze over cooled cake, sprinkle with sugar. Place cherries on floor of cake plate and in the center of the cake.

The campers will get a chance to learn about being a zookeeper and working hands on with small mammals, birds, insects, amphibians, reptiles and aquatic animals. They will also be working with "The Beetle Experience" and have visits from "Aquarium Central" and the "Urban Naturalist". Each day the children will be sent home with a craft and some incredible memories. The children will have an afternoon to play on the splash pad as well as a nature hike, bird walks and bug walks. All the animal ambassadors are friendly, socialized and nonvenomous.

The camp will be held July 10-12. Spaces are limited and campers must be signed up by July 1st. The cost is \$200 per child and this includes 3 days from 8am-6pm with a presentation for the family the last day. Lunch and snacks are provided. WHY WE FUNDRAISE AND WERE IT GOES

As an organization, we often get asked 'What do you do?'. So I thought that 6 months into 2019 might be a good point to let you know what we've 'done' so far with the money that we've raised from people just like you and with the help of dedicated volunteers.

To date, we've spent about \$14,282 on creating programs for patrons, advertisement and promotion. That includes the 4 events that we've hosed at the park (*Chamber Luncheon, Cracklin' Cooking Demonstration, Stir the Pot Seafood and Wild game Cook-off and Festival and Pictures with the Easter Bunny*). And we also attended or created a presence at 7 different events (*cook-offs, festivals, markets*) hosted by other organizations to promote the park.

Sometimes the State's budget is a little short and Palmetto Island has a need that is not funded. That's were we can help if asked. We've spent a little over \$1,900 directly on park needs so far this year.

- electrical breakers
- wood and screws for shop repairs
- nuts and bolts to repair picnic tables
- · chemicals for splash pad
- PVC pipe to repair waterline at canoe launch
- a new starter for lawnmower
- a new pump and fittings for the splash pad.

We'll keep doing what we do! Thank you for helping us make it possible!


GOOD NEWS FROM THE PARK

The cabins have all received new air conditioning systems, just in time for summer. For reservations call toll-free: 1-877-CAMP-N-LA (1-877-226-7652) The Reservation Center is open Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. CST.

The park's manager also shared with us that Office of State Parks plans to resurface the splash-pad sometime next month. So it will be closed for 1-2 weeks. The dates haven't been decided yet but the park will post something as soon as they finds out.







Park Hours of Operation:

Gates are open 6am-9pm (Sun-Thurs) and 6am-10pm (Fri & Sat). Entrance station is open: 8am-5pm (Sun-Thur) 8am-10pm (Fri & Sat). All park sites close at 10pm on Friday, Saturday and days preceding holidays. Entrance Fees: \$3 per person; Free for Seniors (62 and older) and children age 3 and under. Canoe rentals are \$25 per day or \$7 per hour. The Splashpad is open April-September, Tuesday –Sunday from 8am to 8pm. Golf cart entry fees are \$10 per day or \$100 for annual pass (proof of insurance is required). Palmetto Island State Park has 96 camp sites, 6 cabins, 4 pavilions, 4 primitive backpack sites, 1 primitive group site and a meeting room to rent.
