

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

All members of Friends of Palmetto are invited to our Annual Membership Meeting on Tuesday, March 26, 6 p.m. at the Vermilion Parish Library.

We'll talk about our past accomplishments and goals as an organization, listen to member comments and suggestions and hold an election for any vacant seats on the board. We currently have board member seats available. We'll also elect our 2019-2020 officers. You must be present at the meeting to be elected to the board. I've listed a little information below for in case your interested in serving on the board.



- You must be a current member. Membership fee is \$15 per family.
- Be available and willing to attend monthly board meetings, held on the last Tuesday of the month at the Vermilion Parish Library in Abbeville.
- Term for each board members is one (1) 3 year term, max of 2 consecutive terms (6 years). *Minimum of 1 year off the board, then can be reelected to the board.*
- All Board members, **not serving as an officer**, shall be required to participate in two of the options listed below:
 - Participate on at least 1 committee per year,
 - ♦ Chair at least 1 event per year
 - Manage an area, program or project of the organization which may include but shall not be limited to: storage trailers, enhancement projects, book program, merchandise and grants.
 - Other options may be created by the Board as deemed necessary or suggested by the individual Board member in keeping with their interest, experience and talents.

We are an organization of volunteers, no compensation will be dispensed for serving on the board. I can't stress enough how engaging our organization is. We are currently the most active community support group of any State Park or Historical Site in Louisiana. With your fresh energy, ideas and passion for the park we'll continue and build the momentum that began 8 years ago.

LATANIER COOKERS' D.O.G. 'CHOW'

KING CAKE BUBBLE UP submitted by Kelly Hebert

2 (12.4-oz) cans refrigerated Pillsbury cinnamon rolls (not Grands)

1 (8-oz) package cream cheese, softened


2/3 cup sugar

2 eggs

1 tsp vanilla

1 cup milk

purple, yellow, green sugar



Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Line 12 inch Dutch Oven with parchment paper or lightly spray a 9x13-inch pan with cooking spray. Separate cinnamon rolls, save icing to use after the bubble up is baked. Cut each cinnamon roll into 4 pieces. Place in bottom on prepared pan. Using a hand held electric mixer, beat together cream cheese and sugar. Add eggs and vanilla, mixing well. Add milk and mix until combined. Pour over chopped cinnamon rolls. Bake for 30 to 35 minutes. Remove from oven and cool for 5 to 10 minutes. Spread cinnamon roll icing over top of casserole. Sprinkle with Mardi Gras colored sugar.

Park Hours of Operation:

Gates are open 6am-9pm (Sun-Thurs) and 6am-10pm (Fri & Sat). Entrance station is open: 8am-5pm (Sun-Thur) 8am-10pm (Fri & Sat). All park sites close at 10pm on Friday, Saturday and days preceding holidays. Entrance Fees: \$3 per person; Free for Seniors (62 and older) and children age 3 and under. Canoe rentals are \$25 per day or \$7 per hour. The Splashpad is open April-September, Tuesday –Sunday from 8am to 8pm. Golf cart entry fees are \$10 per day or \$100 for annual pass (proof of insurance is required). Palmetto Island State Park has 96 camp sites, 6 cabins, 4 pavilions, 4 primitive backpack sites, 1 primitive group site and a meeting room to rent.
