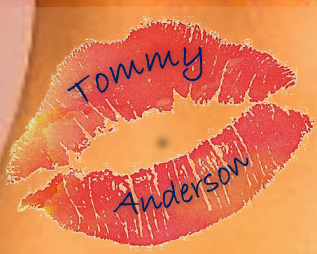


December Birthdays!
