You must be a Redding resident and a senior in public or private high school, or in homeschool. You must be pursuing studies with an environmental focus, such as environmental science, horticulture, floral design, or environmental-related marketing, photography, or social media.

Applicants must complete a minimum of 10 volunteer hours supporting environmental-related activities. Volunteer hours must be completed before April 22, 2026.

- Volunteering at Redding Garden Club's Fall Boutique

- Volunteering at nature-related organizations in Redding, such as Redding Trails, Highstead Arboretum, and New Pond Farm
- Volunteering at the Redding Parade Path garden
- Offering social media skills to the Redding Garden Club
- Offering marketing skills to the Redding Garden Club
- Create artistic exhibits related to nature

- Participate in Garden Therapy activities
- Create floral arrangements for areas throughout the Redding community



Sample Ideas of Volunteering Opportunities for Redding Garden Club Scholarship:

Volunteer Activity		
“Blooming Books” event at Mark Twain Library	Select a book (fiction or non-fiction) that you have read and create a floral exhibit that depicts elements of the book. Display your creation with the book at the Mark Twain Library’s “Blooming Books” event (usually held in March).	
Pollinator Garden at Joel Barlow High School	Assist with weeding, mulching, watering, pruning, planting, etc.	
Civic Beautification sites throughout Redding, including the Parade Path garden on the Town Green	Site managers often need help with weeding, planting, watering, and edging these beautiful gardens.	

Holiday Boutique	<p>Assist in setting up the boutique's merchandise displays and/or help with sales at the event. Held in December, but you can also volunteer to make things to sell.</p>	
Spring Plant Sale	<p>This sale takes place at the beginning of May. We definitely need volunteers to help us with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Media to market the event • Digging up and dividing plants from members' gardens. Each year, RGC members contribute perennials, and many need help dividing and potting. 	
Social Media Posts	<p>Create posts and reels promoting Garden Club activities, such as the beautiful work RGC does in town, and putting out the call for volunteers.</p>	
Make arrangements for Town Hall, schools, Heritage Center, Parks and Rec, etc	<p>At various times of the year, we create floral arrangements that are placed on display throughout the community. We invite you to make an arrangement for display!</p>	
2027 Redding Garden Club Tour	<p>We will need volunteers to assist in a number of ways. Tour managers will inform you of our needs.</p>	

Garden Therapy	Participate with Garden Club members in special workshops where we make small floral arrangements that are donated to area hospice patients. You may also consider connecting with local senior citizens offering assistance with their gardens and horticulture.
