Unit Description

Licence to drive a multi combination vehicle.

What is the purpose of this course?

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to obtain a licence to drive a multi-combination vehicle. It includes systematic and efficient control of all vehicle functions, monitoring of traffic and road conditions, management of vehicle condition and performance, coupling and uncoupling of dollies, and effective management of hazardous situations.

Assessment of this unit will be conducted under a wide range of driving conditions by an assessor who has been accredited by Roads and Maritime Services & Access Canberra.

Who is this course for?

Multi-Combination vehicles include:

- ❖ B-doubles
- ❖ Road trains
- ❖ Prime mover, low loader dolly and low loader trailer combinations

Do you need a licence?

To be eligible for an MC licence course, you must:

- ❖ Have held a Class HR or HC licence or equivalent for at least 1 year. Any time you've spent on a P2 HR licence counts, but you can't practice to drive an MC vehicle, or upgrade to an MC licence until you hold a full class HR or HC licence;
- ❖ Pass the 'Combination' Driver Knowledge Test (DKT);

Prior to booking in an upgrade with Beck's, students will be required to complete their knowledge test to gain the L's permit. There is currently only 1 provider in Canberra who offers this test, Road Ready and for NSW knowledge tests students will need to attend their local NSW RMS Service Centre. We highly recommend anyone complete their online practice test prior to completing their actual test.

Below are links to the relevant sites for both the ACT and NSW knowledge test practice tests. Please note: these are practice tests only. You will need to attend either the Road Ready Centre in Mitchell or Kambah or your local NSW RMS Service Centre to complete the actual test.

If a student to moving from HC to MC licence, they may not have to complete their knowledge test prior to attending a licence upgrade. If the current licence is held in the ACT, a knowledge test is not required prior to a licence upgrade. If the current licence is held in NSW and is more than 3 year old, a knowledge test will be required to be completed and a Heavy Vehicle Competency Based Assessment Learner Logbook be issued.

How long does the course take?

ACT & NSW LICENCE HOLDERS ONLY

MC licence upgrade is **only** offered as a 2-day course that includes 12 hours training and practical drive assessment.

For ACT licence holders, this course is offered as an accredited course that is delivered on behalf of Ascent Training Services (RTO 88096). This course includes a pre-theory component and an in class theory component. Clients will be required to have a A USI number is compulsory and must be obtained in order to receive a qualification.

Please note, if a student currently holds an open licence, they may choose to complete their licence upgrade in an automatic or synchro gearbox and keep their open conditions on their licence.

Beck's Transport Training can currently only offer MC licence upgrades in an auto vehicle unless the client chooses to complete the training and assessment in their own vehicle.

What qualification do I get?

If you choose to complete the accredited licence upgrade, this course is based on the requirements of the Heavy Vehicle Competency Based Assessment (HVCBA) Scheme & Access Canberra competency requirement. If successful in completing the theory component and final drive assessment, you will be issued with a statement of attainment (SOA) by our RTO provider.

If you hold a NSW licence, you will can choose to complete a non-accredited licence upgrade. You will be issued with a competency sheet that will need to presented along with your learner logbook to NSW RMS Service Centre.
