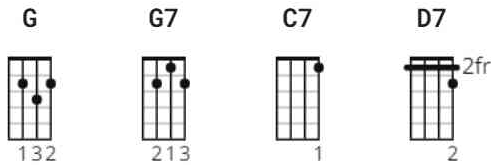


# Folsom Prison Blues Ukulele by Johnny Cash
