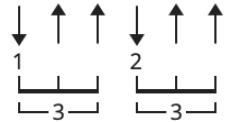


My Favourite (Old) Things - Parody of Julie Andrews song

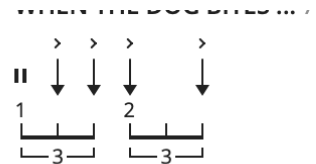
[Em]Botox and nose drops and needles and knitting,
