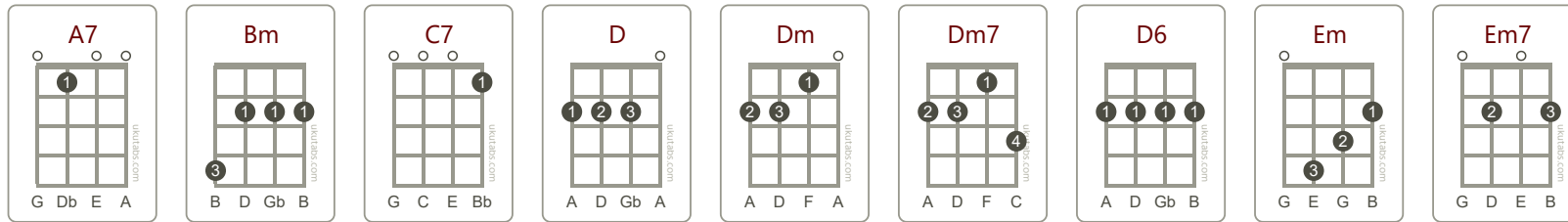


THE FOOL ON THE HILL
