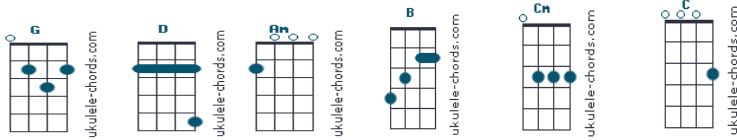


Who wants to be a Millionaire?
