Driver Requirements

- ✓ Driver must be 25 years of age or older
- ✓ Must have a valid CDL Class A license
- ✓ Must have at least 2 years of verifiable CDL experience
- ✓ Must have a clean MVR with no major violations and no accidents in the last 5 years
- ✓ No DUIs or DWIs

Required Certifications

- ✓ Medical Card long form (5 pages)
- ✓ Safeland PEC
- ✓ H2S (Hydrogen Sulfide)
- ✓ Respiratory Fit Test (3M Half Mask)



Respiratory Fit Test Certification



A respiratory fit test is a procedure that ensures a tight-fitting respirator fits comfortably and provides the wearer with expected protection.

There are two types of fit tests – qualitative and quantitative. The Qualitative fit test is a pass/fail test that is usually used for half-mask respirators and relies on the wearer's sense of taste, smell, or reaction to an irritant to detect leaking.

The respirator fit testing must be done in person. The average cost is approximately \$50 to \$70, not including the respirator and the certification expires annually. You may search for a facility near you to obtain this certification.

H₂S (Hydrogen Sulfide) Awareness Training

Hydrogen sulfide (H₂S) certification courses teach people how to identify H₂S, avoid exposure, and what to do if they are exposed. They may also cover how to limit the dangers of H₂S through preventative measures and personal protective equipment.

The H₂S training certification is valid for one year from the date of completion.

The course may be taken online or in person and the average length is 1 to 2 hours. The cost for the H₂S training certification is approximately \$20 to \$30 not including the H₂S monitor. The H₂S monitor is required PPE.

PEC Safeland is a safety awareness training program for the oil and gas industry that was developed by the oil and gas operators to replace multiple operator orientations. The course is designed to give students a general understanding of safety issues in the industry.
