What Is Siftr?

- a social media style geo-specific app
- a tool for documenting and sharing River features
- a field research tool

Getting to Siftr

- Download iOS or Android “Siftr” app
- Using any browser, go to siftr.org to download app.
- Siftr appearance and function are the same across platforms.



Creating an account

- Go to siftr.org or open app
- Select SIGN UP
- Select Create Account (It is free)
- Provide an email address
- Create a username and password (Note: Your username is viewable to other users)

Find our River Map

- LOGIN with username and password
- Search Siftr using 41355 or “Headwaters of the Yahara River”
- Open Headwaters of the Yahara River: Once you’ve open this Siftr, Select follow or Join, it makes it easier to immediately get to the next time you open Siftr

Post a photo to Siftr to share with other River users

- 1 Press the “+” sign
2. Take a picture with your phone. Geotag feature should be turned on on your mobile phone
3. Select a Category (These are evolving as we post and use this app. You can change later)
4. Answer the prompted question
5. Select “Post”
