Welcome

Foxholm is situated in the lovely peaceful village of Sawdon, on the edge of the North Yorkshire Moors National Park. It has a comfortable luxury en-suite guest room. The super king bed can be split into single beds if required. Guests comment on how comfortable it is. We have been awarded 4 star rating with extra silver award and a breakfast award. The room overlooks the beautiful garden, which has a variety of seating areas for guests to relax and enjoy the views over the dale. The en-suite has double ended bath with shower over.

At a Glance

Level Access

- The main entrance has 1 step. There is no lift and no ramp.
- There is level access from the main entrance to:
 - Hall

- Dining Table

Access with steps

- There are steps from the main entrance to:
 - Garden

Level access bedrooms

- The route to the bedroom is 750mm wide, or more.
- There is unobstructed floor space 1200mm by 900mm, or more.

Hearing

- The (bedroom) TVs have subtitles.
- All staff have disability awareness training.

General

- Staff are available 24 hours a day.
- All staff have disability awareness training.
- We have emergency evacuation procedures for disabled visitors.

Parking

- We have a car park. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Entrance 10m from car park. All flat. From the car park to the entrance, there is level access. The route is 1500mm wide, or more.



Arrival

Path to main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The path is 1200mm wide, or more.
- The path is sloped.

Main entrance

- The door is 800mm wide.
- The main entrance has 1 step.

Getting around inside

Hall

- From the main entrance to reception, there is level access. The check-in desk has a low section for wheelchair users. You can sit down at reception.

Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights, floor standing lights, bedside lamps and natural daylight.
- Lights are LED and energy saving. TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- No bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- Not suitable as dogs live in the house
- We can move the bedroom furniture, to improve accessibility.

Place to eat and drink

Hall

- From the main entrance to the dining area, there is level access. The route is 900mm wide, or more. To get to a table, there are no steps.

- The route through the dining area is 800mm wide, or more.
- There is background music sometimes.
- The table and plates have high colour contrast.
- We cater for vegetarian and lactose free (dairy free) specific diets.

Getting around outside

Garden

- From the main entrance to the gardens, there is 1 step. There is no lift and no ramp.

- We have emergency evacuation procedures for disabled visitors.
