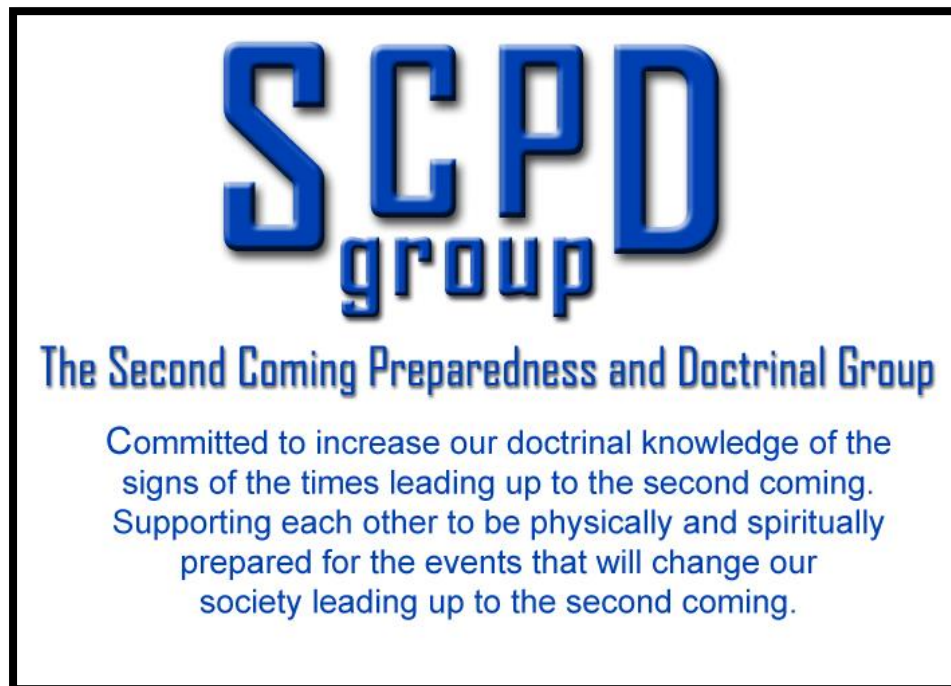
Therefore, I'd like to start a study and support group and I'm inviting you to be a part of it.
