So many people have been working to prepare this great day for all of us to enjoy each other's company in a relaxed atmosphere, with music and food and the anticipation of winning one of the many great prizes being raffled off. Our diligent ministry leaders have been steadily selling the tickets and we are almost sold out. Thank you for taking a chance on winning one of the great prizes.

On Tuesday July 15, I will be going back to Montreal to spend some much-needed time with my children and grandchildren. I will return the evening of August 7. Father Abraham Abui, from Nigeria, will be here for Mass and the sacraments. Please give him a warm welcome and help him feel at home while he's here.

Summer housekeeping – A couple of things should be noted. Although, it may get very warm in the summertime, we should nevertheless come to the sacred liturgy appropriately dressed. As Christians we should dress in a modest manner, wearing clothes that reflect our reverence for God and that manifest our respect for the dignity of the liturgy and for one another. Father Abui will expose the Blessed Sacrament after daily Mass for at least one hour after Mass. The church will be opened on demand. See Leanne in the office.

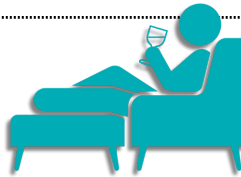
Eutrapelia | July 14 to August 8
