NOVEMBER 30, 2025 The First Week of Advent BULLETIN

Advent

In the last week of ordinary time, the Church presents us with readings from the Prophet Daniel and his various visions of events that will take place in the future. Friday's reading (Daniel 7: 1-14) provides us with a prophetic vision that reveals God's sovereignty over history, the defeat of worldly power and the identity of the Messiah. It is one of the clearest images in the Old Testament scriptures that points to Jesus.

The passage is full of nightmarish images of tremendous beasts rising up out of the sea as the "four winds of heaven" stir up the oceans. The beasts are horrible and destructive. And as all this mayhem is happening, Daniel sees thrones being set up and "An Ancient One took his throne, his clothing white as snow...his throne in fiery flames... thousands of thousands ministering to him...myriads upon myriads attending to him. The court sat in judgement and the books were opened."

Ahh, yes, the beasts were tried and destroyed and their dominion over the earth was taken away. And then Daniel saw, "...one like a Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven..." When he was presented to the Ancient One, this "Son of Man" received dominion, glory and kingship and his "dominion is an everlasting dominion...his kingship shall not be destroyed."

What an amazing vision Daniel had some 600 years before the birth of Jesus Christ. He saw the world as it was and as it is: full of chaos, destruction, anarchy, nihilism, selfishness, greed, mayhem and, yes, murder, lots of it. That seems to be the way of the world.

But the second part of this vision is that he sees the Word become flesh, he sees the Son of Man walk among us and show us the way, the truth and the life. The Jewish people were waiting for him for millennia.

And then he came, "...a shoot came out from the stump of Jesse", on a winter night in a little town called Bethlehem. The great King comes to dwell among us in strict poverty and dire straits. It seems like an odd choice by any standard. Except Jesus' standard. With him, the thinking is always counter to the way the world thinks. Blessed are the poor. Love your enemy. The first shall be last. Take the lowest place at the banquet. Turn the other cheek. Go the extra mile.

And so, he came. The long wait was over. He established a New Covenant with his people; the new everlasting covenant in which his blood is poured out for us and for the forgiveness of sins. He left us his Church so that people could be with him on earth until the end of time eating his Body and drinking his Blood so that we may become like him as he lives in us.

The season of Advent is upon us once again. It's the season when we allow ourselves to wait along with Abraham and Moses, David, Isaiah, Daniel, the Maccabees in solidarity with all of Jewish history. We wait for his coming. Advent - to come - advenire - to come, to wait for something or someone who is coming. We spend four weeks full of anticipation, preparing to receive this Christ Child with great joy. Let us, once again, prepare our hearts to welcome him and spread his Good News: Emmanuel, God is with us.






