## Stewardship Reflection - The Solemnity of Pentecost Come Holy Spirit, Come

This is a powerful prayer. Say it with me: Come Holy Spirit, Come! Come Holy Spirit, Come! Come Holy Spirit, Come! Powerful!

Who is the Holy Spirit?

Jesus told Nicodemus, "The wind blows where it wills, and you can hear the sound it makes, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes; so it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit." (John 3:8)

Both the Greek word 'pneuma' and the Hebrew word 'ruah' may mean wind, spirit, or breath, they are often interchangeable.

The Apostles were filled with the Holy Spirit after "there came a sound of a rush of a violent wind" that filled the entire house where they were sitting. Fifty days before that moment, the resurrected Jesus appeared in the room with his disciples, saying, "Peace be with you...And he breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit." (John 20: 21-22) God breathed into the nostrils of a lump of clay and created the first man. "The Lord God formed man out of the clay of the ground and blew into his nostrils the breath of life, and so man became a living being." (Genesis 2: 7)

So you see, in biblical terms, breath, movement of air, wind: all have something to do with life. They all have something to do with Spirit. "It is the spirit that gives life...the words I have spoken to you are spirit and life." (John

The Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Trinity. The Church teaches that the Holy Spirit is the personal love between the Father and the Son. He is at work with the Father and the Son since the beginning when he hovered over the waters of a formless earth, and will continue until the completion of the divine plan for our salvation.

He is the Advocate who speaks on our behalf and whom Jesus told us the Father will send to "teach you everything and remind you of all that I have said to you" (John 14: 26)

And yes, he does just that! Whenever we need to know something, have a decision to make, a task to perform, he will teach us how to do it, what to say, what to write. He will remind us of all of Jesus' teachings and how they apply to any circumstances in which we may find ourselves. All we need to do is call on him. Because to be in touch with Christ, we must first have been touched by the Holy Spirit.

"One cannot believe in Jesus Christ without sharing in his Spirit. It is the Holy Spirit who reveals to men who Jesus is." (CCC 152)



Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful,

Enkindle in them the fire of your love, Send forth your spirit and they shall be created,

And you shall renew the face of the earth.

It is good to understand our relationship with the Holy Spirit. Call on him.








## **Stay Connected Archbishop Smith**
