Be Thou My Vision

*Be Thou my vision, O Lord of my heart;
Naught be all else to me, save that thou art.
Thou my best thought, by day or by night,
Waking or sleeping, Thy presence my light.*

Do you know that hymn? It's one of our most beautiful hymns but we don't sing it much in the Catholic Church for some reason, I'm not sure why not, it dates back to 9th century Ireland.

But it is a brilliant theological thought – asking God to always be “my vision”, that which I see. Your presence is my light that allows me to see the traces of God everywhere.

Ultimately, it is our destiny, at least it's our goal, to find ourselves in front of the “Beatific Vision” that is God himself and when we are in heaven, we will be able to withstand his gaze upon us as we are welcomed into his unadulterated presence. O Happy Day!

Last week, in my homily, I spoke about a vision my wife had while I was with her in our car not long before she died. It was a vision of “people helping one another”. In some ways it seemed like a vision of heaven.

I've been thinking a lot about visions and vision lately. I've been thinking a lot about this parish and where it's headed. What is the parish vision? I think about a multitude of ideas about what our church will look like in ten or twenty years. What will the campus look like? What will Laval Square look like? And more importantly, who will be here? Will the church be lively and full?

Will the church be the hub of the neighborhood as it was in the days of the pioneers? Will there be lineups for confession and full Sunday Masses and many daily communicants?

I can't help but think about these things. I guess that's my job. And so my job is also to remind you of your responsibility of envisioning the future of the parish. Because what the parish will be like in the future depends on you, the parishioner, in collaboration with the pastor and leadership teams.

And so I ask you to think about this: What do you love about this parish? What drives you crazy about this parish? Ponder these questions and see what you come up with. Then you can share your vision of the parish with me and I just might share my vision with you. What the parish will be in the future depends on you and I sharing our vision and then collaborating to make it happen. And of course, this work can only be done with the full participation of the Holy Spirit because it needs to be a visible manifestation of God's love, a vision of God that we are seeing.


