What's the Point?

O you can't get to heaven In Uncle John's shoes Cause Uncle John's shoes Are big as canoes. I ain't gonna see my Lord no more! (Old camp song)

If you can't get to heaven in Uncle John's shoes, then how do you get to heaven? There must be a better way. Indeed!

We started up our PREP program on Wednesday evening. PREP is the Parish Religious Education Program for children who are Catholic but are not enrolled in a Catholic school. They get their faith education and sacraments through this program at the parish.

So, I was telling the students that the most important thing is to get to heaven. Everybody agreed - it is so important. But how do you get there is the question. Everyone wants to get to heaven, but nobody wants to pay the price. What does it cost?

Oh, only your life. But think about it, your life is a gift anyway. You didn't do anything to get it. It was given to you by God. And he keeps giving it to you every moment. Like even right now. He's holding you in being. You exist because he wills you to exist. He wills you to exist because he loves you.

So, our lives are worthless without him. We're so much better off when we offer our lives back to him. Otherwise, what's the point? So how we get to heaven, as the PREP students are learning, is by answering God's call.

St. Paul tells us that we must,

...clothe yourselves in compassion and kindness, humility, meekness, and patience. Bear with one another and, if anyone has a complaint against another, forgive each other, just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you must also forgive. Above all, clothe yourselves with love which binds everything together in perfect harmony." (Colossians 3:12-14)



And that my brothers and sisters is how we get to heaven. And as the PREP students will be able to tell you, getting to heaven is the point!


