Stewardship Reflection - Fourth Sunday of Easter



We didn't have to wait too long for this momentous moment. The Book of Revelation proclaims, "Look! The lion from the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has won the victory." It is speaking, of course, of Christ. And the new Vicar of Christ on Earth has chosen the lion's name for his moniker, Leo XIV.

I was particularly gratified by his choice of name because of his predecessor Pope Leo XIII's influence on our society through his teachings on Catholic Social Justice. Like a lion, he went after capitalism in the world and its abuses of human dignity and exploitation of workers as the industrial revolution took hold. And just as ferociously, he laid bare the dangers of Marxist philosophy and soulless communism.

His encyclical *Rerum Navarum* (1891) still rings loudly in our world today as it set up the very reasons that Catholics (and, of course, all people) need to understand why the killing of innocent human life is unacceptable in all circumstances. Which is why we march for life, pray for life and witness to the world that there is nothing more precious in the world than a human life – every human life.

Many of us went to Victoria, B.C. on Thursday together, to march, to pray and to share our message of joy. I was honored to be asked to do the opening prayer at the rally on the steps of the British Columbia Legislature building. Here is my prayer:

Brothers and Sisters,

Let us pray,

In the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Lord, we come together before you in solidarity, recognizing each other's intrinsic worth and inherent dignity. We are in solidarity with each other and also with those who are most vulnerable, those with no voice, who cannot speak for themselves or defend themselves.

Lord, we ask you to help us to see ever more clearly the truth and the power of your love so we may share your love most abundantly with others, especially with those whose eyes have been veiled and cannot see the transcendent possibilities in LIFE. Lord, we ask you to guide those whose lack of imagination prevents them from knowing the value of human life.

Guide us in love to lead others to the truth, the truth that every human being has the dignity of being made in your image, a dignity that is equal for everyone, whether they are a super athlete, a Nobel prize winner, a homeless person, a person in a coma, an embryo, a fetus, a child. They're all yours, Lord. Let us treat them with equal dignity as you do. Let us love them as you do.

You have commanded us through your prophet Moses, "I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse. Choose life."

AMEN.




Prayer for Pope Leo XIV

All couples planning to be married in this Parish should contact the pastor at least 6 months in advance. Non-parishioners must obtain written permission from your parish.




