St. Jean Baptiste Day Mass in French

Come, celebrate St. Jean Baptiste Day on June 24. For Catholics, it is the feast day of the Nativity of St John the Baptist. Of those born of women, no one is greater than John the Baptist (Luke 7:28). For the French-Canadian community in general, it is an important cultural holiday. Pope Pius X, in 1908, declared St. John the Baptist to be the patron saint of all French-speaking Canadians, regardless of where they live in Canada. The Mass will be followed by a traditional French Canadian celebration with music, jigs, reels, dancing and food. Come and be a French Canadian for a day! Tout le monde est le bienvenue! 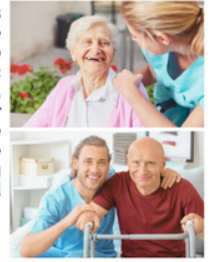
