### **WELCOME**

We welcome all visitors. If you are new to the Parish, please fill out the registration form available at the entrance to the Church. And please introduce yourself to our pastor, Father Larry.

Those of you who know me well are aware that I've been studying the piano for the past twelve years or so. I must admit, it is very difficult and I'm not very good at it, but I am persistent. I found an excellent piano teacher, Agnes Wan, our wonderful choir director, who taught me so much about the basics. But after a few years I felt the need to expand into jazz, so I found a good jazz teacher about three years ago

I know jazz is not everyone's cup of tea but for me, it moves my soul. There's something about the juxtaposition of discordant notes in a chord that when put together with other chords makes beautiful sense. The journey through the song is never predictable. It leaves one hanging on for the ride. Jazz can be very complex yet the joy and the genius of it is that there is great freedom.

I can't remember to whom this quote is attributed but it perfectly sums up the jazz experience.

"Jazz has something all people need to succeed:

"freedom within tremendous discipline."

This creative freedom requires both facility in judgment and in the execution of that judgment: to know what note to play and be able to play it."

This is how life is. Whatever we are trying to accomplish in our lives, it will only happen with tremendous discipline. It takes work; it takes discipline; it takes perseverance. When we master a certain skill, then we have the freedom to move around in it and even break new ground.

You want to play golf? It takes a lot of discipline to swing the club correctly so the little ball goes where you want it to go. The more command we have over a skill the more we can break free from the tyranny of the rules, from the feeling of being boxed in because we are novices in that skill.

Professionals make the task look easy, but make no mistake, an extraordinary amount of work went into perfecting that swing or that piano piece.

This is true of the spiritual life. I think the idea of "practicing the faith" is really that: practicing so we get better at it. Some people go to Mass every Sunday, are faithful, and are of course, 'practicing the faith'. But left at that, there's very little growth. Someone who doesn't pray every day, and I mean in an intimate way with the Lord, would need to grow in prayer in small increments, to build up spiritual 'muscles' as it were, to have their prayer experience deepen gradually over time. Eventually, they will be able to find intimacy with God in any situation. They will have the freedom to move around in their spiritual life in a way previously unknown to them. They will find and maintain peace in their heart and walk around sharing the joy Jesus wants for all of us. That's freedom. And spiritually, we can take God's melody, turn it inside out, run to new heights and bring it back to the standard melody we all know. Our freedom allows us to go to places we couldn't have known before. Freedom within tremendous discipline - and all that iazz.







#### **RCIA**


