

Way back in April, I wrote a two-part reflection entitled "Relics and Sacramentality of the Catholic Faith". I wasn't planning on writing on that subject again, but I have some exciting news concerning relics and our parish.

I mentioned back then that I was having difficulty in determining what saints' relics were in our altar. I had mentioned that in the early persecutions of the Church, Mass was often offered, by priests and congregations hiding in the catacombs using the tomb of a martyr as the altar. That tradition has carried on through time so that every main altar in a church has been consecrated and relics of saints, especially martyrs, are secured somewhere in the altar. This is why the priest kisses the altar at the beginning and the end of the Mass.

Part of the exciting news is that I have discovered whose relics are beneath the altar at Our Lady of Lourdes. Who would you guess would be there? Drumroll......

St. Bernadette Soubirous, of course, the young girl and visionary to whom Our Blessed Mother spoke at a grotto in Lourdes, France in 1858 telling the world that she is the Immaculate Conception.

The other saint is St. Marauerite **Bourgeoys** (1620 - 1700) the founder of the Sisters of the Congregation of Notre-Dame in Montréal in the colony of New France. She and her sisters educated young girls, the poor, and children of First Nations. She is known for founding one of the first uncloistered religious communities in the Catholic Church.

The other exciting news is that I discovered, in the back of a cabinet, one of the most important relics that exists: a relic of the True Cross. We brought it out on the Feast of the Exaltation (or Triumph) of the Cross, and carried it in procession before the Saturday morning Mass last week. It is a wonderful blessing that our parish possesses such a venerable relic.

But wait, there's more: I found another relic that appeared to be only a wax seal. Upon investigation, I discovered that the case for the relic had been damaged and that, inside was a relic of St. Francis of Assisi.

There is also one relic of St. Catherine Labouré who is said to have relayed the request from the Blessed Virgin Mary to create the Miraculous Medal, now worn by millions of people around the world.

After all these great discoveries, I feel that our parish is being blessed. As such, I would like to honor the relics by housing them in a proper way that would allow the parishioners access to see them and arranging special days of veneration on the feast days of the saints. I believe these are signs of God's blessing on us and I am deeply humbled and grateful for this turn of events.






Project Advance 2024




