Project Advance is one fundraising tool, and we will also have a few fundraising events and concerts in the coming year in order to source income from, not only our parishioners, but from the people in the neighborhood. We need each other. The church will be an asset to the neighborhood and the neighbors will be good for our church. And remember, that's why we must
