

Joy

Shout for joy, O daughter Zion! Sing joyfully, O Israel! The Lord your God is in your midst, a mighty savior. He will rejoice over you with gladness, and renew you in his love, He will sing joyfully because of you As one sings at festivals.

Zephaniah 3: 14, 17

I hope that sometime in your life, you will have had that feeling of pure joy that makes you feel like you're going to explode and you feel compelled to shout or sing or dance just to contain yourself. I have been blessed with that over the top feeling a few times in my life.

Once it happened in Yukon while I was filming with Bishop Gary Gordon on a beautiful, freezing day in December, when the sun peaked over the horizon for about an hour. I stood observing the beauty of my surroundings, breathing in the icy air, and even as my camera was freezing up, I had a sense of overpowering joy. I spontaneously shouted "YES" at the top of my lungs.

I didn't know it at the time, but the joy I felt and my loud 'yes' were for God. Only many years later did I realize that **it was my yes for the priesthood**. I could not have known at the time (my wife was still alive) and yet in retrospect it is quite

clear to me that that's what it was. He was calling me with joy.

My joy was very much connected to the passage from Zephaniah above. I think I must have felt taken care of, that God was rejoicing over me with gladness.

Did you know that God sings? "He will sing joyfully because of you!" Isn't that amazing and wonderful? I think God was singing joyfully because of me that day in the Yukon and his singing made my heart soar and I shouted YES, not even knowing why.

I try to maintain that joy throughout my life. Obviously, there are trying times when I lose the intensity of my joy but that's ok. The joy is underneath all the other emotions and thoughts and ideas. Through it all, the hard times and the losses, the joy is there in my heart, like a pilot light that is protected and will not go out.

This is Gaudete Sunday, the third Sunday of Advent. It's all about the joy in anticipation of what is to come: the celebration of Jesus' birth on earth. The defining moment in all of history is the Incarnation. The actual Incarnation happened at the Visitation of the Angel Gabriel to Mary nine months previously. During the time of Mary's pregnancy, Jesus, the Second Person of the Holy Trinity, grew in flesh, passing through the stages of normal fetal development, zygote, embryo, fetus, baby boy. And on Christmas morning he joined us in this dark world bringing light and that abundant joy that only he can bring. Truly, on that morning, he brought Joy to the World.

Jubilee Year of Hope 2025



The Holy Father has declared that 2025 will be a year of Jubilee, something which happens every 25 years. The theme is "Pilgrims of Hope", and it will be a year of hope for a world suffering the impacts of war, the ongoing effects of COVID-19 pandemic, and a climate crisis. The Vatican revealed the official logo of the Jubilee Year 2025, which it says, depicts humanity coming from the four corners of the Earth in the act of clinging to the Cross. The cross is in the shape of a sail, one of the signs of Christian Hope that carries with it the certainty of the victory of good over evil. A sail that imposes itself on the sea moved by the happenings of life. The cross ends in the shape of an anchor, another symbol of hope that brings confidence and security in life. The Jubilee Year will begin on Christmas Eve, 2024, when the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica opens, and end on January 6, 2026, when the Holy Door closes.




