"I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete. This is my commandment. love one another as I love you." John 16: 11

Gaudete Sunday, the joyful Sunday, the Sunday of Advent in which the entrance antiphon begins with the word REJOICE!! Because that's what God is calling us to do, Rejoice!

Funny word, joy. Jesus uses it here in the context that he is going out to endure his passion, the worst night of his human life, his suffering and dying on the cross the next day - it's against that backdrop that he explains to his Apostles that the culmination of all his teachings and the example he showed them through his ministry and his leadership was that, no matter what happens, he wants them and us, to have his joy in us always. "That your joy may be complete."

So having his joy in us must be really important. The Lord wants nothing less than that we carry his joy around with us. It makes sense. If you have children, doesn't it give you joy to see that your child is joyful and is thriving? It's no different with the Lord, we are his children; he created us out of the sheer gratuitous love he has for us and he wants us to be joyful and thrive in our lives.

The beauty of his joy is that we get to hold on to it even when times are not so good. We sometimes think we can only have joy when everything is going our way, and we stop having joy when we are suffering through some trial or other. But no! That's exactly the time that the Joy of Jesus Christ will carry us over the hump.

The Accuser, the devil, wants you to feel bad and will tell you that you're no good and you don't deserve to have joy. He'll tell you that you are not worthy enough. And the trouble is, we often believe him and we carry our guilt and our shame around with us even though we have confessed our sins and have been forgiven. Somehow the Accuser will get under our skin and awaken our worst fears about ourselves and we believe him. And we lose our joy.

But our joy is not fixed on our circumstances, our joy is fixed, looking through our circumstances to our God who is bringing us through to the other side. It is precisely our joy that helps us through the difficulties. Our joy is not determined by our struggles but by our future destiny and our destiny is the person of Jesus Christ.

Our joy is a fruit of the Holy Spirit, along with love, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, gentleness, goodness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, and chastity. We receive joy when we are using the gifts of the Holy Spirit well. (wisdom, understanding, fortitude, knowledge, piety, fear of the Lord) So you can see that joy, true joy, is not superficial; it is rooted in God, through Jesus and the holy spirit. And therefore, our joy runs deep in our being. That's why we shan't lose our joy so easily and let circumstances dictate our well-being. Our joy needs to be like the ocean deep and not be disturbed by the howling winds of arbitrary circumstances on the surface.

So "Rejoice in the Lord always, again I say rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near". (Philippians 4: 4-5)




