

Happy New Year

It's that time of year again. The liturgical cycle keeps on turning. A new liturgical year begins on the First Sunday of Advent. The wisdom of the Church has us go through the scriptures, the Gospels especially, in a three-year cycle.

Each liturgical year consists of a cycle of six seasons:

- Advent four weeks of preparation before the celebration of Jesus' birth
- Christmas recalling the Nativity of Jesus Christ and his manifestation to the peoples of the world
- Lent a six-week period of penance before Easter
- Sacred Paschal Triduum the holiest "Three Days" of the Church's year, where the Christian people recall the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus
- Easter 50 days of joyful celebration of the Lord's resurrection from the dead and his sending forth of the Holy Spirit
- Ordinary Time Wherein the faithful consider the fullness of Jesus' teachings and works among his people. (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, Second Vatican Council).

The Paschal Mystery of Jesus Christ—his suffering, death, and resurrection-is continuously proclaimed and renewed through celebrating the events of his life and in the feasts of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the saints.

This mystery of Christ, unfolding through the cycle of the year, calls us to live his mystery in our own lives. This call is best illustrated in the lives of Mary and the saints, celebrated by the Church throughout the year.

1st SUNDAY OF ADVENT

1st Reading: Isaiah 63.16b-17; 64.1, 3-8 2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 1.3-9 Gospel: Mark 13.33-37

We are entering the Year 'B', which is considered the year of Mark, having just gone through the year 'A', the year of Matthew. Next year is, you guessed it, Year 'C', the year of Luke. And then we start all over again. Well, what about John, you might ask. The Church chooses to bring in the Gospel of John sprinkled throughout every year because it is more deeply theological and less of a running account of his travels. It is a Gospel that offers us more intimate access to the person of Jesus so that, "... you may come to believe that Jesus is... the Son of God and that through believing you may have life in his name."

So, here we are in Advent, a season that has a two-fold nature: it prepares us for Christmas, when we recall Christ's first coming among us. But you will also note, through the scriptural readings, it is a time when we look forward to his second coming at the end of the ages.

Either way, Advent is a season of joyful expectation. It's a time to prepare ourselves spiritually to welcome the Lord. It's a time to contemplate and prepare for a grand celebration. That celebration is Christmas, and it begins on December 25 and goes through to the Epiphany of the Lord on January 6.

Our secular world would have it backwards. Long before Advent we are inundated with CHRISTMAS or XMAS or THE HOLIDAYS, PARTIES and SLEIGH BELLS, SANTA and SALES, SALES, SALES. "Resistance is futile!", they would have vou believe.

It's not true. Please DO resist the temptation to enter the frenzy of consumerism. Spend time in quiet contemplation and prayer.





PROJECT Empowering our Parish Vision


Empowering Our Parish Vision




