40 Days for Life will be starting on Ash Wednesday for 40 Days of Lent

We have a core group of people here at Wouldn't you agree that this is a horrible Our Lady of Lourdes, who are dedicated to promoting the cause of life - the idea that life is a gift from God and is precious and therefor inviolable. The first of human rights is the right to life because without that, no other rights matter.

Our world, our government, promotes the death of those in the womb by abortion and those outside of the womb by assisted suicide. From the first group we take away their right to life without their permission. The second group are killed because they give up their right to life. Very often, and I mean very often, they are coerced into giving up that right.







Our Lady of Lourdes



Our Lady appeared to a poor, very poor, peasant girl on a chilly day in southwestern France in 1858. Her family had suffered a series of misfortunes that left her father without work. The family of six were forced to live in a twelve by fourteen-foot room that was part of an abandoned prison. It was dank and dark. But it was from this place that Bernadette left on February 8, 1858, with a sister and a friend to go collect wood for kindling. The girl, Bernadette Soubirous, was not very healthy and the other two girls went ahead of her. She stopped to take off her stockings to cross a stream when she felt a gust of wind. She looked around and there was nothing else stirring. Soon it happened again, and her attention was drawn to a light high up in the grotto. The light was shaped like a girl. "I saw a lady dressed in white. She wore a white dress and an equally white veil, a blue belt and a yellow rose on each foot." Bernadette felt afraid and automatically reached for her rosary and made the sign of the cross. As she did this, the beautiful lady did the same and they said the rosary. When the prayer was over the lady suddenly vanished. This was the first of eighteen times Our Lady appeared to Bernadette over the next three months.

And so begins the story that has changed the life of millions through the intercession of our Blessed Virgin Mary. She herself told Bernadette her name when she said – "I am the Immaculate Conception". The muddy ground that she scratched on command from "the beautiful lady" turned into a spring that is flowing till this very day. Thousands have been healed of all sorts of infirmities by bathing in that water and countless graces have been received by people who have visited the shring

Our Lady's message to Bernadette was always "Pray, pray for sinners and repent." That is her message to us. And we, parishioners and friends of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish are especially called to heed her message which, really, is the message of her son, Our Lord Jesus.




