

Life: It's Priceless!

What's a life worth? To some, life is cheap. Some people kill at the drop of a hat. In a war zone, say, Gaza, a life isn't worth a plugged nickel. To an abortionist, the life of a fetus is no life at all and worth only what fetal tissue and body parts will fetch from the research market.

But really, how can we put a price on life?

Well of course we can't, I hear you say. But we do all the time. Check in at your local hospital, care home or hospice and see what kind of value is placed on one actual life. Find out how a person's life is considered on balance with the cost of care or a person's potential for productivity or perceived usefulness.

Since euthanasia was legalized in Canada in 2016, there have been well over 50, 000 people killed by what they call medical assistance in dying, a distorting euphemism if there ever was one. Euthanasia is the taking of a human life. It is killing, usually by injecting a fatal combination of drugs into a person.

It is not medical assistance in dying; it is the taking of a life. Real medical assistance for people who are dying takes care of the patient, helping to make them comfortable, using good nursing practices, caring for the whole person: body, mind, and spirit. That is what good, compassionate hospice care looks like. This holistic outlook empowers close friends and relatives to journey with the patient, allowing for compassion to be offered and accepted so that true, healing, closure may come about, and grief may proceed naturally.

1st Reading: Jonah 3.1-5, 10 2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 7.29-31 Gospel: Mark 1.14-20

Grief is a process that profoundly affects all concerned and is integral to the healing process.

Euthanasia short circuits that process, leaving friends and relatives with no closure, with no way of developing their grief. Here one minute, gone the next. But we are so much more than our bodies.

The real problem though, is one of ownership. The pro-euthanasia slogan says, "My Body, my Death, my Choice." St. Paul, in his letter to the Romans says, "We do not live to ourselves, and we do not die to ourselves. If we live, we live to the Lord, if we die, we die to the Lord; so then, whether we live or whether we die, we are the Lord's."

Bishop Robert Barron asks the question, "Does the slogan get it right? Or does St. Paul get it right? Does my life belong to me or is it a gift from God?"

For Catholics, the answer is obvious. But please don't misunderstand. Being against euthanasia and abortion is to truly see suffering and to share in the suffering, to "suffer with" (which is the actual meaning of compassion). It is to accept life in all its complexities and suffering and the struggles that human beings face. It is to take on those struggles in solidarity with our brothers and sisters and to know that suffering is a very real part of human existence.

We may live in a world that believes that the killing of innocent human life is a legitimate solution to problems and inconveniences, a world that desires to stamp out suffering by decree.

But there is hope. And our hope is in recognizing the truth of the dignity of the human person and to realize that a single human life is worth more than an entire universe of material goods. **Each and every human life is priceless!**
