

What Do You Do?

Before my life changed drastically when my wife died and I was called to the seminary and eventually to priesthood, I was a cinematographer. A what?

A cinematographer, the Director of Photography on a film, is the person responsible for the visual look of a film and works with the producers and the director to execute their vision of the film. My job was to make the film come alive off the script, through the vision of the director, striving to keep the audience's eye on the storyline, creating an appropriate environment for the actors while managing a major part of the budget overseen by the producers.

I suppose you could say that there are many different skills involved in bringing it all together. I developed many skills over the years, coming up through the ranks, being mentored and learning from people with more experience than I. And yet, I had to rely on a variety of skills that my crew members had that I did not possess. I learned the virtues of humility and teamwork.

It takes teamwork to run a parish, yes, and humility. Many of the skills I used in filmmaking are transferrable skills that I use as pastor every day. And two things I know, you don't make a film by yourself, and you don't run a parish by yourself. It's teamwork.

A few weeks ago, I printed a chart in the bulletin, simply showing the number of tasks, ministries, duties, and obligations that are inherent to the parish. I did that to give you a graphic idea of what

needs to happen in the parish. I thought that, perhaps I could twig a reaction from you, Dear Parishioner, and to help you see yourself somewhere in that picture.

I believe that everyone has some skills, maybe even a gift that has been given to them from God. Do you have musical skills? Can you play the piano? Can you sing a song? Can you fix a faucet? Mow a lawn? Tend a garden? Paint a wall? Are you a good listener? Can you visit someone who is perhaps old and shut in? Can you see yourself as an Extraordinary Minister of Communion? Maybe you have skills in organizing a committee. Maybe you can count money. Maybe you can make coffee or prepare a meal? Are you interested in liturgical things? Maybe you could help out in the sacristy or help to serve Mass or be a leader with our youth. I could go on, but I won't.

The thing is, it takes a lot of work, teamwork to be precise, to help the parish thrive - to be an inviting place where people may feel welcome. We're here to bind up wounds - most of us are hurting. Why not help yourself by helping out in the parish. By helping others to heal, we heal ourselves. That's the Law of Love.

So what do you do? Your skills and gifts are valuable assets. Money is necessary for the parish, for sure, and I am very grateful for the folks who contribute to the church. But your time and your talent are far more valuable. Please consider offering them back to God through his holy people, your fellow parishioners.






