The Love of God Is All Around Us

The crows are angry today. Their harsh, guttural caws have been relentless all morning. Their tree, the large, thick pine tree in front of the rectory, has been invaded by young, roaming racoons. Being invaded is unsettling, to say the least, and the crows are angry. Unfortunately, it's part of life. No one likes being invaded, whether it's our personal space or our country. That is the dark side of life. But there is something far more powerful than that.

The love of God is all around us. Do you see it? Can't you feel it? Do you know how much your existence matters? Sometimes we lose sight of this profound fact: My life matters. In my life, in your

life, there is a beautiful balance to be found, a balance of joy and suffering; of mercy and justice; of pleasure and pain. Because this life is but a pilgrimage, a rite of passage to eternal life, we must go through difficulties, tragedies, loss, and we are called to overcome them.

Their also exists much beauty, truth, joy, and peace in the world and this is the light that we need to overcome the darkness of pain, suffering, tragedy, or invasion.

The crows deal with it the only way they know how: they react, they caw, they flock together and fly against the enemy.

We humans know much better how to deal with such anguish. We have the light of Christ and his teachings. We have the Prophet Isaiah speaking for God:

"For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, my thoughts higher than your thoughts."

We human beings have the love of God, and we need to strive to elevate our thoughts and our ways to a higher level that is more God like than the crows are able to do.

Life is ultimately a struggle. There is too much suffering in the world. But the love of God is all around us and all we need to do to access that love in times of struggle, or any other time, is to open our hearts, open our eyes, open our ears, and open our mouth and say, "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit...come to my assistance."




















Join the Operation Baby Bottle Fundraiser!




