

"In the past decade our culture has seen growing acceptance of transgender ideology - that is, the claim that a person's biological sex and personal identity have no necessary connection and could in fact, contradict each other. According to this view, "human identity" is self-defined and "becomes the choice of the individual." Consequently, our culture is experiencing a rapid rise in the number of persons claiming an identity contrary to their biological sex. Attempts to accommodate such claims already have resulted in tremendous upheavals in our social, legal and medical systems.

situation presents a serious This challenge for all members of the Church because it presents a view of the human person contrary to the truth."

This is from the introduction of "A Catechesis On The Human Person And Gender Ideology" by the Most Reverend Michael Burbidge, Bishop of the Diocese of Arlington, Virginia.

We are living in a world in which the basic tenets of our beliefs, of our Catholic beliefs, are being denied and teased out from the strong foundations on which our society was built. Basic beliefs such as,

> "God created man in his image; in the divine image he created him; male and female he created them."

(male) is somehow ignored and children are encouraged to "be who they feel they are". But we know "from medicine, natural law, and divine revelation, that each person is created either male or female, from the moment of conception." Pope Francis writes, "lt needs to be emphasized that biological sex and the socio-cultural role of sex (gender) can be distinguished but not separated...It is one thing to be understanding of human weakness and the complexities of life, and another to accept ideologies that attempt to sunder what are inseparable aspects of reality." Amoris Laetitia, no. 56.

There is a deep rift in our society over this fundamental issue of identity. lt behooves us, as Catholics to know and understand the basic human anthropology from a Catholic point of view.

"The Church's teaching rests on three principles, all knowable by way of human reason.



First, the human person is an 'embodied soul,' the composite of the spiritual and physical. To be a human person means to be a unity of body and soul at the moment of conception, a human person."

Second, the human person is created male or female.

Third, the differences between man and woman are ordered towards their complimentary union in marriage.
