Is God Dead?

I think one of the hardest things, as Catholics, is to engage in conversation with a person who has little regard for our faith and yet is not afraid to debunk the Church and Christianity everv opportunity.

Have you ever met that person? I sure have. I'll bet you have also. That person is usually someone in our family, sons or daughters who went to university and learned that God is dead.

That is, after all, the prevailing view in the secular world and, in a sense, they are correct. God has died; we have killed him. Friedrich Nietzsche declared God dead back in the 1880's and his writings have been a deep influence on the way modern people think about God and religion ever since.

I say he is correct because it is the people who, even back in his day, were Christian on the outside, yet have no relationship with the Man who suffered and died for us on the cross, and allowed the world to push God out of their daily lived experience. God was a shell; the Church a façade.

A great example of this is in Québec. In the 1960's ninety-five percent Quebecers went to Mass on Sunday. By the year 2000, that percentage is about three or four percent.

Quebec society today has embedded secularism in the law and has made it the official religion of Québec. They believe that God is dead and has to be replaced by their own gods: the gods of equity, diversity, the French language, etc. True story.

Of course we know that God is not really dead but is fully alive in each and every person. But we can truly say that Christendom is dead. By Christendom, I mean the empty shell kind of religion that exists at least since the Enlightenment. That is dead. We're in a new era now. We can no longer expect people automatically be on board with our Christian values, sometimes not even our own children.

So we always need to be ready, as St. Peter suggests in our second reading today, (1 Peter 3:15-18) "Always be ready to make your defense to anyone who demands from you an accounting for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and reverence."

You have hope. Be ready to make an account - know your faith. Go to the many Catholic resources available on the internet. Know why you believe what you believe. No, God is not dead. He's very much alive and he loves you and he loves that person that you are going to tell how much God loves him or her.
