





#### Jubilee Year 2025 Opening Mass





My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Christmas is almost here, the New Year is upon us, I'll be going to Montréal on January 2, returning on January 9. Therefore this is the final bulletin of a most extraordinary year at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish/ La Paroisse Notre Dame de Lourdes, and I thought this might be a good time to reflect on who we are as a parish and what we have accomplished in 2024.

The vision for the parish that I have tried to articulate, is in some ways best said in a comment from a parishioner of another parish who was passing by and remarked, "With the beautiful Christmas lights, the church is beginning to feel like the heart of a Town Square."

#### Exactly!

Our Lady of Lourdes should feel like the steadfast rock, the shelter from the storms of life, the peaceful refuge, the town square where the neighborhood comes together in community, and not only for our parishioners but for our neighbors, as well.

#### The church is

That's Our Lady of Lourdes, a cornerstone of the Village of Maillardville where Catholicism lives and thrives. It is a place that gives identity to the neighborhood. It's supported by the people in the neighborhood even while it is supporting them. It reaches out to those in need and meets the spiritual needs of our parishioners and all people living in Maillardville. (see Bulletin of Oct. 20)



I believe we are well on our way to achieving that. The following is a list of events and notable changes and what you, the parishioners have accomplished during 2024:

- We ran the Catholicism series of Bishop Robert Barron. Ten episodes of sheer beauty and great information on what it means to be Catholic.
- The Knights of Columbus ran a series on strengthening the family, entitled "Into the Breach".
- We offered a showing of season 4 of the TV series "The Chosen" on Tuesday mornings in St. Anne's Hall. It was very well attended and created its own community for discussions of biblical themes.
- Our post Mass "Coffee and Donuts" run by several groups, Choir, CWL, Couples for Christ, Knights of Columbus, and PREP Parents, has been an excellent way to bring our community together and where many ideas and plans for the parish are hatched, and growth happens.
- Speaking of growth, our parish has grown with many new parishioners and the official word is that Mass attendance is up by over 7%. And we have welcomed approximately 20 new families into our parish.
- We have been diligently moving forward on the Basement Renovation Project. We are working with Oberto Oberti Architecture and Westbourne Projects with Giulietta Roz as our project manager. The construction company will be chosen this week. Construction will begin in March and is due to be completed in July. We hope to be operating the hall/venue by August.
- We participated in many pro-life initiatives:
   The March for Life in Victoria, 40 Days for Life, Baby Bottle Campaign for Pregnancy Concerns, Walk/Run for Life Life Compass Society and we hosted two First Saturday Pro-life Masses.
- Hosted two concerts by the choral group that calls Our Lady of Lourdes home, Les Echos du Pacifique.

RCIA – We had one catechumen baptized, confirmed, received the Holy Eucharist and one candidate, a young man who was welcomed into the Church.

- PREP Catechesis for our children who are not in Catholic schools. They learn about our faith. We have a very dedicated group of teachers and parents who themselves want to learn more about the faith.
- Kneelers We have reupholstered and repaired all the kneelers in the church.
- New Front Doors We have recently replaced the front doors of the church with dignified, custom-made, red oak doors that look like church doors. This was paid for by a Legacy donation from the late Mrs. Marguerite Finnigan.
- Processions around the square: Stations of the Cross on Good Friday, The Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, and on Corpus Christi Sunday, a procession with the Holy Eucharist.
- Family Fun Day on July 14 to kick off the summer and raise funds for the basement project. With prizes, games, garage sale, music, food, and fun, we raised \$20,000.
- Project Advance you were very generous.
   The tally is not in yet, but I know we have come close to our goal of \$70,000 and our participation rate has increased to over 30%.

   Thank you.
- Our Lady of Guadalupe our Spanish speaking parishioners from Latin America organized a special Mass (partly in Spanish) and fiesta with great food from various Latin American countries for this special celebration of Our Blessed Mother.
- Simbang Gabi This year we have teamed up with All Saints Parish to share in the presentation of the Simbang Gabi Novena of Masses before Christmas. This is a Filipino tradition that we are all encouraged to celebrate during the Advent Season.

- We have happily hired a few new people this year:
  - Rudy Arnuco, Custodian a delightful, generous man who is keeping the parish campus beautiful, clean, and in good repair.
  - Leanne Penco a very accomplished and competent administrative assistant. She is organizing the workflow for Father Larry and coordination with the various teams.
  - Agnes Wan she was helping with the choir last year but now she is the Director of Music (with Roger De Villa). Agnes is a music teacher and brings great skill to help our choir improve constantly.
  - Marilyn Sarte Coordinator of Lay Formation. Marilyn is a long-time parishioner who has dedicated herself to the salvation of souls at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish. She oversees PREP, RCIA and other lay programs.

As you can see, my brothers and sisters, there is a huge commitment by many of our parishioners to bring about the salvation of all souls – the stated mission of the Catholic Church. It is a large undertaking and the rewards for doing so are even larger. I'd like to thank everyone who participates in our parish, in any way. Your willingness to open your hearts and respond to the initiatives that are offered is heartwarming.

I wish you and your families to have a blessed celebration of our Lord's Nativity, and that you are able to spend precious time with loved ones and share the Peace and the Joy that Christ has shared with you. May God bless you and keep you in the New Year.
