If you have been fortunate enough to have been following The Chosen television series about Jesus and the Gospels, and have watched all the way to the end of the fifth season, as the credits rolled over the end of the last episode, which ends with Judas dramatically kissing Jesus on the cheek, you will have heard this most beautiful hymn brilliantly performed by two sisters, The Secret Sisters. The hymn is entitled Flee As A Bird and was written by Mary Dana Shindler in 1857.

It is a haunting melody with lyrics that begin with a line from King David's Psalm 11, which says,

"In the Lord I take refuge; how can you say to me, 'Flee like a bird to your mountain..."



The mountain, in biblical terms, is usually a place where we find God. Think of Moses and the burning bush, or Moses receiving the Ten Commandments on Mount Sinai, or Elijah who, on the run from Jezebel, finds God in the "still, small voice" on Mount Horeb. By the way, Mount Horeb and Mount Sinai are one and the same mountain, and the two names are used interchangeably in the Bible.

Think of how many times Jesus himself went to the mountain to pray by himself, to be with his father.

Think of the Transfiguration on Mount Tabor, where Jesus met both Moses and Elijah, and the voice of his Father rang out saying, "This is my son in whom I am well pleased. Listen to him."

David was frequently going to the mountain seeking refuge from his enemies, especially King Saul. And here in Psalm 11, he's saying, "Why should I flee to the mountain? My refuge is in the Lord."

Ah, but David also knew that we find God on the mountain.

But who is the hymn addressing? "Thou who art weary of sin..."

That's me! I'm weary of sin. Aren't you? Aren't you tired of sin and its awful effect on our lives. The sins of judgement and unforgiveness, the sins that cause us to give away our human dignity, the sins of anger and vengeance, the sins that leave us destitute and unhappy? Flee like a bird to your mountain! And when you find our Lord, know he "will wipe ev'ry tear."

Try finding the hymn and the Secret Sisters on YouTube and give it a listen. I guarantee you will be moved. Maybe someday soon we might even hear our lovely choir do their rendition of it. Here's hoping!
